This year saw the 11-year anniversary of the Stock Exchange of Thailand's philanthropic awards "Recognizing the People who do Good Works for Society." These awards are conducted in co-operation with local organizations working in various fields to better society in Thailand, and each organization will nominate one or two worthy recipients each year. Across the 11 years, there have been a total of 87 recipients who have

done beneficial things for society and communities in Thailand. The 2017 awards recognized 11 people in seven fields on March 20. Awardees receive a monetary prize to help fund their on-going work. The DPF is one of the co-operating organizations and our award category is drug prevention, which is presented under the name of "The Prateep Ungsongtham Hata Award." This year DPF chose two awardees: Mr. Sawat Thammasujarit, who has conducted anti-drug activities in slum communities by teaching football to children, and Mr. Warin Arjwilai, who started the Emmanuel Music School teaching Klong Toey children to play classical music. Congratulations to both recipients and we wish them ongoing success in doing good things for the underprivileged children in the Klong Toey communities.
